Costa Blanca

The Costa Blanca or 'White Coast' is actually the part of the Valencian Province that runs along the Mediterranean sea, although as a holiday destination it is better known as a region in itself.

It was named by the World Health Organisation as having the healthiest climates in the world, due to its consistently warm temperatures, and more than 315 sunshine days in a year. It boasts endless miles of beautiful sandy beaches, such as those at the better known resorts of Benidorm and Alicante. These resorts are extremely popular with young groups and couples looking for the nightlife, water sports and theme parks. The rest of the coastline is stunning and unspoilt with breathtaking mountain and valley views.

Going inland to southern Costa Blanca there are some beautiful palm gardens and attractive towns, some of which seem to have hardly changed for centuries. The north of the region is mountainous, and relatively green, with olive groves and colourful orchards.




Getting There

Villa Tocino

Located in a tranquil setting within its own almond grove with beautiful 180° views of the surrounding mountains.

This villa offers a peaceful retreat from the hustle and bustle of the coast but only 30 minutes drive from the A7 motorway and 40 minutes from Alicante Airport, or 1¼ hours from Murcia Airport, on the Costa Blanca. The village of Hondon de los Frailes is five minutes away with local bars, cafés and shops. There is also a supermarket just over the mountain in Albatera, a 15 mins drive.

The accommodation consists of one double and two twin bedrooms; two bathrooms – one en-suite; large lounge/dining room with traditional fireplace, radiators in all rooms for winter lets, satellite TV, DVD and CD players; a well designed kitchen with cooker, hob, fridge-freezer, microwave and a utility room with washing machine. Outside there is a stunning 8 x 4m pool, paved all round; large covered sun terrace and a garage all set in a sizable garden which is securely fenced in and surrounded by almond and olive trees. This tastefully decorated and furnished villa is ideal for anybody, at any age, who wants to enjoy the real Spain in a relaxed atmosphere, benefits from an all-year-round warm climate but is in easy reach of the many coastal attractions on the Costa Blanca.

Hondon de los Frailes

This historical location of La Romana in Lumbam, Hondón is a new village that gained its independence from the other Hondón, Hondón de las Nieves, in 1926. Its name results from having belonged to the Orihuela Jesuits in the 17th century.

A typical agricultural village, 74% of its land is given over to farming, mainly of grapes, olives and almonds though it also produces other crops that grow on irrigated land. Citrus fruits, vegetables and dates are some of the typical produce grown, which farmers take to markets throughout the province. In addition to agriculture, hemp products such as brooms and brushes are also produced.

The Crevillente Mountains

The surrounding mountains provide ideal walking for enthusiasts and casual ramblers. The area is particularly attractive for cyclists for its testing mountain passes which reward you with spectacular views.
